SUBJECT: HAZARDOUS WASTE TRANSPORTATION, RECYCLING,
AND DISPOSAL SERVICES CONTRACT

Members of the Board:

On June 27, 2000, your Board approved an agreement with Philip Transportation and Remediation, Inc., for household hazardous waste transportation, recycling, and disposal services. Since approval of that agreement, changes in treatment facility requirements have resulted in new restrictions for certain wastestreams. Bulked flammable liquids containing over 50 parts per million of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) can no longer be handled as a fuel substitute and must now be sent to a specialized incineration facility at a price of \$775 per drum. As the County's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Facilities typically only generate 1 to 2 drums of this material annually, no increase in contract costs is anticipated.

In addition, a pricing structure has been added for non-pourable or solidified bulk fuels. The County's HHW Collection Facilities do not typically generate this type of material, but on rare occasions bulked flammable materials may solidify after packaging and require a higher level of treatment. The added pricing for this treatment service is \$245 per drum.


Attached for your consideration is an amendment to agreement for addition of a rate for treatment of bulk fuels with PCBs and non-pourable or solidified bulk fuels. No increase in contract finding is required.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve an amendment to agreement with Philip Transportation and Remediation, Inc. to add pricing for treatment of bulk fuel drums.

2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the amendment on behalf of the County.
