ACCEPT UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FOR THE MULTIPUPOSE SENIOR SERVICES PROGRAM

Dear Members of the Board:

As you know, the Human Resources Agency (HRA) is responsible for administering the Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP). MSSP provides comprehensive case management services for frail elderly persons in an effort to prevent or delay long-term institutionalization. The program is limited to Medical recipients and is fully funded through a contract with the California Department of Aging. This letter requests a resolution Ii-om your Board to accept unanticipated revenue that has been allocated by the Department of Aging.

The Governor's Budget for FY 2000-01 contained an augmentation for MSSP programs statewide. The Department of Aging established an allocation formula and has awarded the Santa Cruz MSSP site an additional amount of \$37, 608.00 for the current fiscal year.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board :

- 1. Approve the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$37,608.00, and appropriate these funds as described in the attached AUD 60; and
- 2. Authorize the Human Resources Agency Administrator to execute the attached contract amendment with the California Department of Aging for the remainder of FY 00/01, on behalf of the County.
