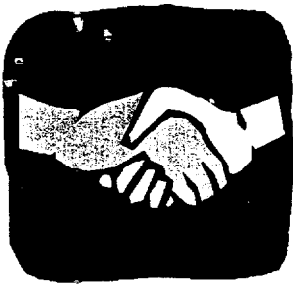

The Local Workforce Investment Board invites you to join other business and community leaders in an exciting opportunity for leadership and vision as we move into the new millennium.

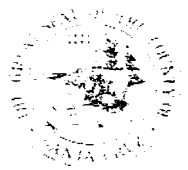
