
### DETERMINATION OF DISABILITY RETIREMENT STATUS OF SAFETY MEMBER

Dear Members of the Board:

Ms. Samantha Starr has applied to the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) for a disability retirement. Under the terms of the Public Employees' Retirement law, an employee is disabled if she cannot substantially perform the duties of the position she occupies. PERS requires that your Board provide, via a resolution, a determination of two issues: (1) whether Ms. Starr is disabled (under the above stated terms); and (2) whether her disability (if so determined) is industrial/work related.

It is RECOMMENDED that your Board approve the attached resolution which states that Ms. Starr is not disabled under the Public Employees' Retirement law.

RESOLUTION DETERMINING DISABILITY RETIREMENT OF  
SAMATHA STARR, GROUP SUPERVISOR II

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz (hereinafter referred to as County) is a contracting agency of the Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether a local safety member, employee of such agency, is disabled for purposes of the Public Employees' Retirement Law and whether such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such law; and

WHEREAS, an application for disability retirement of Samantha Starr employed by the County of Santa Cruz Juvenile Hall in the position of Group Supervisor II has been filed with the Public Employee's Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such alleged disability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors find and determine and it does not hereby find and determine that Samantha Starr is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees' Retirement Law for performance of her duties in the position of Group Supervisor II.


