HAZARDOUS MATERIALS APPEALS COMMISSION 2000 ANNUAL REPORT

I. Role of the Commission

The Commission is directed to receive, process, adjudicate, and issue orders in connection with written appeals and/or applications made to the Health Officer pursuant to County Code Chapter 7.96 (Hazardous Waste Permits), 7.100 (Hazardous Materials), and 7.110 (Ozone Depleting Compounds).

II. Meeting Dates

Upon receipt of an appeal, the Clerk of the Commission sets the matter for hearing not later than thirty days thereafter.

III. Commission Structure

The Hazardous Materials Appeals Commission is appointed by the Board of Supervisors and consists of a County Supervisor; a person with knowledge of hazardous materials who has been/is employed by a business or establishment that has used/uses hazardous materials; and one member representing the general public.

IV. Commission Staff

The Hazardous Materials Appeals Commission is staffed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and by the Environmental Health Service of the Health Services Agency.
