

#### 2000 ANNUAL REPORT

##### I. ROLE OF COMMISSION

The duties of the Commission shall be: (1) to hear appeals of Poundmaster Orders and of denials of unaltered animal certificates issued by the Poundmaster; (2) to exercise any other responsibilities set forth in the By-Laws, as approved by the Board of Supervisors.

##### II. MEETING DATES

Upon receipt of the appeal, the Clerk of the Commission shall set the matter for hearing not less than five nor more than forty-five days after the date the appeal is received by the Clerk.

##### III. COMMISSION STRUCTURE

The Animal Nuisance Abatement Appeals Commission consists of members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, one from each district.

##### IV. COMMISSION STAFF

The Animal Nuisance Abatement Appeals Commission is staffed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and by County Counsel.
