REPORT ON THE COMPLETION OF INTERNET ACCESS FOR THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY CODE

Dear Members of the Board:

On December 12, 2000, your Board approved the agreement with Book Publishing Company (BPC) of Seattle, Washington to provide the conversion of Volume I and Volume II of the County Code into hard copy and on-line formats in order to facilitate access to the Codes by the public. The scheduled time for completion was April 15, 2001.

BPC delivered the hard copy version of the County Code and provided the host Internet address: <http://www.bpcnet.com/codes/santacruzco.htm>, to link to our County's home page, on April 13, 2001. BPC worked diligently to meet the April 15, 2001 deadline and this project exemplifies their commitment to providing quality services to their customers.


As a result of this conversion, we estimate our yearly costs will be \$5,000 and our per page supplement cost will be reduced from \$23 to \$19 per page. 
It is therefore recommended that your Board:
