SUBJECT: PROPOSITION 12 FUNDS


Dear Members of the Board:

On April 4, 2000, your Board directed the Parks Commission to prepare recommendations for your Board with regard to the utilization of the Proposition 12 Funds. As you will recall, Proposition 12 includes a per capita funding allocation which can be utilized for acquisition, development, rehabilitation and restoration of real property for park purposes. It is anticipated that the County's per capita share will be approximately 1.4 million dollars.

The Parks Commission has been discussing possible uses for the Proposition 12 Funds in all of its meetings since August. The Commission's March and April meeting agendas were extremely busy with Public Hearings concerning the Pinto Lake Master Plan Amendment and the proposed Highlands Skate Board feature and therefore did not have an opportunity to discuss Proposition 12 funding. It is anticipated that the Commission will complete its discussion of Proposition 12 funding at its next few meetings.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board defer this item to 'Budget Hearings.
