GRAHAM HILL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT NO. RPSTPL-5936(033) AND SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT AT VARIOUS BRIDGE LOCATIONS, NOS. 36C-0018, -0068, -0073, -0078, -0092, -0114, -0134, -0075, AND -0116

Members of the Board:

Attached are Program Supplements No. M026, No. M017, and No. M013 Rev. 1 to County-State Agreement No.05-5936 with an authorizing County resolution. These agreements provide federal and/or state funding reimbursement for preliminary engineering, construction engineering, and construction of the Wilder Ranch Bike Path Project (M026), preliminary engineering for the Graham Hill Road Improvement Project from Roaring Camp Road to 0.64 miles south (M017), and reimbursement for right-of-way for the Seismic Retrofit Project for various bridge locations (M013 Rev. 1). These program supplements allocate a total of \$354,000 for the Wilder Ranch Bike Path Project, \$100,000 for Graham Hill Road Improvement Project, and \$85,000 for the Seismic Retrofit Project.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve Program Supplements No. M026, No. M017, and No. M013 Rev. 1 to the County-State Agreement No.05-5936.
- 2. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing agreement between the State of California and the County of Santa Cruz for funding preliminary engineering, construction engineering, and construction of the Wilder Ranch Bike Path Project, preliminary engineering for the Graham Hill Road Improvement Project from Roaring Camp Road to 0.64 miles south, and right-of-way for the Seismic Retrofit Project for various bridge locations.

- 3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the original and duplicate originals of the three Program Supplements on behalf of the County.
- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the original and duplicate originals of the signed agreements, together with one certified copy of the authorizing resolution attached to each supplement, to Fardad Falakfarsa, Chief, Office of Local Programs Project Implementation, California Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 942874, MS #1, Sacramento, CA 94274-0001.

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
