SUBJECT: SET A PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT THE CONCEPTUAL PINTO LAKE COUNTY PARR MASTER PLAN AMENDMENT

Dear Members of the Board:

At the 2000-2001 budget hearings (June 27, 2000), your Board approved the Department of Parks, Open Space & Cultural Services budget which included funding in the amount of \$70,000.00 for the updating and revision of the Master Plan for Pinto Lake County Park.

On February 6, 2001, your Board approved the design contract with SSA Landscape Architects Inc. to facilitate the process and produce the Master Plan Amendment.

The public meeting process has been proceeding well. To date, one Parks Commission Public Meeting and two other public meetings have occurred. A Parks Commission Public Hearing is scheduled for May 21<sup>st</sup> where it will be the staff recommendation that the Parks Commission adopt the proposed Conceptual Master Plan Amendment and forward it to your Board for public hearing.

Support for the amendment and general attendance at the public meetings has been high. The Parks Department will continue to specifically provide notice to those individuals whose property adjoins the site along with those who have been put on the mailing list by past attendance and request. These mailings will be done in addition to the typical advertising the Department performs.


