**SUBJECT: BROWNS VALLEY ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT
STATE BRIDGE NO. 36C-125, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. BRL-5936 (026)
BID AWARD**

Members of the Board:

The Board of Supervisors received five bids for the Browns Valley Road Bridge Replacement Project on May 1, 2001. The engineer's estimate for project was \$1,442,378.25. The low bid, received from Buglar Construction was for \$1,890,950.00. The five bids were reviewed by staff and found to be in order.

The County has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 12 percent for construction contractor services. While Buglar Construction was only able to achieve a 9.3 percent DBE participation, they have provided sufficient documentation indicating that a good faith effort was made requesting participation by qualified DBE subcontractors.


Funding for award of this critical bridge replacement project is included in the 2000/2001 Road Budget with the unanticipated cost covered by local match funds from projects that were either deferred until the 2001/2002 budget year or funded in the 2000/2001 Pavement Management Program. In addition, it will be necessary to use \$99,195.00 in Measure E funds from the Paulsen-Whiting Road Bridge Improvement Project to complete the local match for the bridge project. The 2001/2002 proposed Road Budget includes replacement funding for all of those projects that were deferred.

The State of California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (HBRR) funding is available for approximately 80 percent of the bridge replacement portion of this project; of this amount, \$650,000.00 represents the additional unanticipated state funding that was not included in the 2000/2001 budget. The City of Watsonville is also funding a portion of the replacement of the City's water line, which crosses the bridge, in the amount of \$69,271 .00. The revised cost of the project, including contingencies, overhead, and administration, now totals \$2,064,248.00. Resolutions to accept unanticipated revenue from the State of California Department of Transportation and the City of Watsonville are attached for your Board's approval.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Accept the low bid of Bugler Construction Company in the amount of \$1,890,950.00 and authorize award of the contract.
2. Adopt the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue from the City of Watsonville in the amount of \$69,271 .00.
3. Adopt the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue from the State of California Department of Transportation in the amount of \$650,000.00.
4. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the contract on behalf of the County.


