SUBJECT: FELTON COMMUNITY HALL ALL-OUT AUGUST

Members of the Board:

The **Felton** Community Hall has requested permission to hold its All-Out August event in **Felton** along Kirby Street and a portion of Gushee Street on Saturday, August 4, 2001. This event will consist of food and beverage concessions, music and dancing entertainment, craft booths, a classic car and motorcycle display, and activities for children.

To facilitate the planned event, it will be necessary to close Kirby Street (from State Highway 9 to Gushee Street) and that portion of Gushee Street for 140 feet north and 200 feet south of the Kirby Street intersection from 1:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the road closures and event, subject to the conditions on the attached road closure permit.

2. Direct the Public Works Department to issue the road closure permit



SUBJECT: FELTON COMMUNITY HALL ALL-OUT AUGUST PERMIT

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Board of Supervisors action dated June 5, 2001, a permit to hold the event and close Kirby Street and a portion of Gushee Street on Saturday, August 4, 2001, from 1:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., is granted with the following conditions:

1. Street closure barricades with detour signs shall be placed at the following locations:
 - a. Kirby Street at its intersection with State Highway 9.
 - b. Gushee Street 140 feet northerly **from** its intersection with Kirby Street.
 - c. Gushee Street 200 feet southerly from its intersection with Kirby Street.
2. **Felton** Community Hall shall furnish at their own expense all barricades, signs, traffic control devices, incidentals, and personnel to comply with all permit conditions.
3. Access shall be provided to emergency vehicles. Clear unobstructed access shall be provided for the **Felton** Fire Protection District.
4. Immediately following the event a clean up shall be made of the entire closure.
5. Control of all traffic shall be coordinated with the California Highway Patrol.

6. The **Felton** Community Hall shall exonerate, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless, the County of Santa **Cruz**, including without limitation, their officers, agents, employees and volunteers from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, defense costs, or liability of any kind or nature which County may sustain or incur or which may be imposed upon it for injury to or death of persons, or damage to property as a result of, arising out of, or in any manner connected with the performance under the terms of this permit, excepting any liability arising out of the sole negligence of the County. Such indemnification includes any damage to the person(s), or property(ies) of the County of Santa Cruz and third persons.
7. The **Felton** Community Hall at its sole cost and expense, for the MI term of this Permit (and any extensions thereof), shall obtain and maintain at minimum compliance with all of the following insurance coverage(s) and requirements. Such insurance coverage shall be primary coverage as respects County and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the County shall be in excess of the **Felton** Community Hall insurance coverage and shall not contribute to it.
8. Comprehensive or commercial general liability insurance coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit, including coverage for: (a) bodily injury, (b) personal injury, (c) broad form property damage, (d) contractual liability, and (e) cross-liability.
9. All required comprehensive or commercial general liability insurance shall be endorsed to contain the following clause:

The County of Santa Cruz, its **officials**, employees, agents and volunteers are added as an additional insured as respects the operations and activities of, or on behalf of, the named insured performed under permit with the County of Santa **Cruz**.
10. All required insurance policies shall be endorsed to contain the following clause:

This insurance shall not be canceled until after thirty (30) days prior written notice has been given to:

11. The **Felton** Community Hall agrees to provide its insurance broker(s) with a full copy of these insurance provisions.

- 12. A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE(S) MUST BE FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AT LEAST TEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT OR THIS PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED. All certificates of insurance shall be delivered or sent to:

- 13. A public notice shall be placed in a newspaper of general circulation giving the time, date, and name of road closures.
- 14. The Felton Fire Protection District shall be notified in writing giving the time, date and limits of road closures.
- 15. All local emergency services and the Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District are to be notified by the applicant of the event and street closures.
- 16. If all the permit conditions are not complied with, the event MAY BE CANCELED by the Sheriff or the California Highway Patrol. If unanticipated traffic problems should occur, the road closures may be canceled.
