ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION L OF SECTION 3.12040 OF THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY CODE RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS OF COUNTY EMPLOYEES FROM CIVIL SERVICE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz ordains as follows:

SECTION i

Subsection L of Section 3.12.040 of the Santa Cruz County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

 - 14. Traffic referee.
