Members of the Board:

As part of the 2000/2001 Plant Budget, your Board allocated funds to replace the air conditioning unit for the Main Jail Administration and Booking areas as well as for the Courtroom located at the 259 Water Street facility. The existing air conditioning unit is over 22 years old and has deteriorated to the point where it must be replaced. The new unit is more energy efficient and is eligible for energy efficiency rebates through P.G. & E., which will offset some of the project cost. Engineering services have been provided by Salas and O'Brien for this project and were previously authorized by your Board. Plans and specifications have been completed and these items and associated documents related to this project must be approved by your Board prior to solicitation of written proposals. Funds for this project will be available in Budget Index 191120/Q17014, Sub-Object 6610. The cost of this project is estimated to be \$135,000.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions:

- 1. Approve plans and specifications on file with the Clerk of the Board for the Replacement of the HVAC Unit at the Main Jail;
- 2. Direct the General Services Department to advertise for bids; and
- 3. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on August 7, 2001.

Prospective bidders must be fully qualified, licensed, certified and insured to perform the work requested. All work performed must meet all current State and local laws and regulations.

Prior to bidding, interested contractors should attend a pre-bid conference and review of the work site conducted by the Engineer.
