I have worked in the mental health field providing services in Santa Clara and Santa Cruz Counties since 1973. Since I became licensed as a Marriage and Family Therapist in 1983 I have worked in a Santa Cruz County Group Home and Foster Family Agency as a social worker, providing services to children in "out of home placement." I am currently Executive Director of Children's Placement Service, which encompasses a Foster Family Agency and Transitional Housing Placement Program for emancipating foster children. I have not previously served on a commission or committee, but feel that my status as a therapist in the community and my knowledge and experience working with The Human Resource Agency (Adult, Family, & Children's Services, Child Protective Services, Project COPE, the Probation Dept., Juvenile Court) during the last 28 years would more than qualify me.
