STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

I am interested in serving as Commissioner on the County of Santa Cruz Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Commission, so that I can further utilize my experience and expertise in the area of EEO, non-discrimination, and affirmative action. Additionally I am interested in serving on the Commission because I am committed to eliminating workplace discrimination, and committed to furthering equity and diversity at all levels of government.

I believe my more than 10 years of professional experience in the area of EEO as well as my education and volunteer experience help to qualify me to serve as Commissioner.

Professionally, I have served as an EEO Analyst for the City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, and as the City's EEO Officer for the City of Santa Cruz. In my eight years at the City of Los Angeles I reviewed, investigated, and resolved dozens of issues regarding allegations of unlawful discrimination and/or harassment, including complaints of sexual harassment, disability, sexual orientation, religion, race, age, and many more. I also authored countless statistical and narrative reports assessing the organizations non-discrimination programs, as well as reports to assess my investigative findings, which included recommendations on ways to address the investigative results. I also represented the City before Federal and State regulatory bodies, and provided legal support to the organization in cases that were litigated. Additionally prepared and presented various reports to appointed and elected bodies, and conducted training on various EEO issues including sexual harassment, affirmative action, and cultural diversity to over 2000 employees. In my present position with the City of Santa Cruz, I have gained additional experience in the above-mentioned areas as well as some new areas. I am currently responsible for monitoring and annually updating the City's Equal Opportunity/Non-Discrimination Assurance Plan, and for staffing the City's Equal Employment Opportunity Committee, which consists of public members as well as City employees. Additionally, I am responsible for: Preparing and presenting the City's Annual EEO Report to the City Council; Investigating and/or mediating complaints of discrimination filed against the City of Santa Cruz; Designing and presenting EEO related training; Conducting Exit Interviews; Conducting the City's outreach recruitment efforts; Preparing statistical and narrative EEO reports; and for representing the City before all Federal and State regulatory bodies.

I believe my education also helps to qualify me to serve as a Commissioner. I hold a Master of Public Administration from the University of Southern California, School of Policy, Planning, and Development, and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Industrial/Organizational Psychology with a minor in Public Personnel Administration from California State University Fullerton. My studies included courses in Gender Issues in Administrative Theory, Labor/Management Relations, Alternative Dispute Resolution, Public Personnel Administration, Collective Bargaining in the Public Sector, Administrative Law, Political Management, and Public Policy Development, Analysis, and Implementation.

Additionally, I believe that my volunteer experience also helps to qualify me to serve as a Commissioner. I served as Board Member and as Board Secretary on two non-profit grass roots organizations - the National Latina Alliance in Los Angeles and the National Coalition Building Institute in Santa Cruz.

I believe my professional experience, advanced education, as well as my personal interest and commitment to address unlawful discrimination issues has prepared me to undertake the duties and responsibilities of Commission Member for the County of Santa Cruz, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.
