SUBJECT: HOLOHAN ROAD BIKE LANE/RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS AND

ASPHALT CONCRETE OVERLAY PROJECT ON SUMMIT ROAD, FELTON

EMPIRE ROAD AND SOQUEL SAN JOSE ROAD

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject bike lane and overlay project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The proposed work provides for the widening of Holohan Road for bike lanes and an asphalt concrete overlay between Green Valley Road to just short of the Highway 152/College Road intersection, and asphalt concrete overlays on Summit Road from Old Santa Cruz Highway to Morrell Road, Felton Empire Road from Empire Grade to P.M. 1.0 and Soquel San Jose Road from P.M. 8.33 to Redwood Lodge Road and from Morrell Road to Summit Road. The overlay of these last three routes will also include an asphalt rubber wearing surface that we expect to significantly improve ride characteristics.

The engineer's estimate for this work is \$2,500,000, not including contingencies or administration costs. The Summit Road pavement work is funded primarily by a State Surface Transportation Program grant, while the Holohan Road bike lane is funded by grants from both the Monterey Bay Unified Air Pollution Control Board (AB 2766) and CALTRANS Bike Lane Account, including local matching funds.

The overlay work in the amount of \$800,000 for the Felton Empire Road and Soquel San Jose Road is made possible through savings from our recent low bid on the 2000/200 1 Pavement Management Overlay Project. The use of these reserves on Felton Empire Road and Soquel San Jose Road will allow us to balance the supervisorial district road funding percentages that were developed for the Pavement Management Program based on the relative amount of maintained mileage in each supervisorial district.



In order to allow sufficient time for the administrative process involved between the time of bid opening and contract award, and to provide for the largest potential number of bidders during this heavy construction season, it will be necessary to open bids prior to the first available Board meeting in August 2001. Public Works is therefore requesting that the Board allow the opening of sealed bids for the subject project in the office of the Director of Public Works on July 3 1,200 1. The resultant low bid would then be returned for the Board's acceptance on or before August 14, 2001. It would be Public Works' intention to request authorization to award the project to the low bidder on that same Board date.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids for this combined bike lane and overlay improvement project.
- 2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on July 3 1, 2001.
- 3. Adopt the attached resolution allowing the bid opening for the subject project to take place in the office of the Director of Public Works at 10:45 a.m. on July 3 1, 2001, with acceptance and award by the Board on or before August 14, 2001.
- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning July 1,200 1, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.

Sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Director of Public Works of Santa Cruz County, Room 410, Governmental Center, no later than **10:30 a.m.**, July **31, 2001,** and at 10:45 a.m. or soon after, they will be publicly opened and read, in the office of the Director of Public Works, 701 Ocean Street, Room 410, Santa Cruz, California, for construction on County roads in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

HOLOHAN ROAD BIKE LANE/RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS AND ASPHALT CONCRETE OVERLAY PROJECT ON SUMMIT ROAD, FELTON EMPIRE ROAD AND SOQUEL-SAN JOSE ROAD

The work to be done consists in general of the construction of bike lanes and resurfacing improvements on Holohan Road and the asphalt concrete overlays of Summit Road, Felton Empire Road, and Soquel-San Jose Road by providing pavement failed area digouts, grinding of asphalt pavement, placement of pavement reinforcing fabric and mesh, applying an asphalt concrete leveling course and applying an asphalt concrete and rubberized asphalt concrete overlay, traffic striping, marking and markers, and guard railing.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required. The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond. The Contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time that this contract is awarded.

The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award
