Members of the Board:

Attached are Program Supplements No. M029 and No. M030 to County-State Agreement No.05-5936 with an authorizing County resolution. These agreements provide federal and/or state funding reimbursement for construction engineering, and construction for both the Valencia Road Bridge No. 36C-0116 Seismic Retrofit Project and the Soquel Drive at Aptos Creek Bridge No. 36C-0075 Seismic Retrofit Project. Program Supplement No. M029 allocates a total of \$1,000,223 for the Soquel Drive at Aptos Creek Bridge Seismic Retrofit. Program Supplement No. M030 allocates a total of \$477,332 for construction of the Valencia Road Bridge Seismic Retrofit.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve Program Supplements No. M029 and No. M030 to the County-State Agreement No.05-5936.
2. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing agreement between the State of California and the County of Santa Cruz for funding construction engineering and construction of the Soquel Drive at Aptos Creek Bridge No. 36C-0075 Seismic Retrofit Project and the Valencia Road Bridge No. 36C-0116 Seismic Retrofit Project.

3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the originals and duplicate originals of the two Program Supplements on behalf of the County.
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the original and duplicate originals of the signed Program Supplements, together with one certified copy of the authorizing resolution attached to each supplement, to Fardad Falakfarsa, Chief, Office of Local Programs Project Implementation, California Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 942874, MS #1, Sacramento, CA 94274-0001.

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## SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

1. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article III MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be the responsibility of the ADMINISTERING AGENCY and shall be performed at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
2. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY agrees that payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Authorization/Agreement or Amendment/Modification (E-76) and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid letter or its modification as prepared by the Office of Project Implementation, Local Assistance Program.
3. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY will advertise, award and administer this project in accordance with the current Local Assistance Procedures Manual.
4. This agreement supplements the ADMINISTERING AGENCY-State Master Agreement for Federal-Aid projects, with the understanding that all provisions of the Transportation Equity Act (TEA-21) apply.
5. State Seismic funds will provide the match to Federal funds and reimbursement of Local Agency overhead costs, relating to seismic project development which are directly attributable to meeting the Local Seismic Retrofit Program mandate.
6. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY agrees to use local funds to match that portion of the work not eligible for match under The State Seismic Program.
7. The ADMINISTERING AGENCY is required to have an audit in accordance with the Single Audit Act and OMB A-133, if it receives \$300,000 or more in federal funds in a single fiscal year. The federal funds received under this project are a part of the Catalogue of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) 20.205, Highway Planning and Research. OMB A-133 superceded OMB A-128 in 1996. Reference to OMB A-128 in Master Agreement (if any) is superceded by this covenant.
8. Award information shall be submitted by the ADMINISTERING AGENCY to the District Local Assistance Engineer immediately after the award. Failure to do so will cause delay in processing the

invoices for the construction phase. Please refer to Section 15.7 "Award Package" of the Local Assistance Procedures Manual.
