SUBJECT: MURIEL DRIVE ROAD BUMPS


Members of the Board:

The residents of the Muriel Drive road bump affected area (see attached map) have submitted an application along with a signed petition of affirmation for the installation of two road bumps. The petition included a **78.6%** calculated approval rate for the installation of road bumps. Bus service is not provided on Muriel Drive by the local school district; therefore, a letter from the local school district stating its position regarding road bumps is not required. The Central Fire Protection District policy on road bumps states "it is not this department's policy or standard to promote the installation of speed bumps that would encroach upon any alley, lane or street utilized by the Central Fire Protection District."

The residents of Muriel Drive have complied with all the provisions of the policy and the street meets all the eligibility requirements for placement of road bumps. The policy requires approval by the Board of Supervisors prior to the placement of the bumps. The developer of Tract **1427**, as a condition of permit number 99-0398, is responsible for the cost of installing the road bumps and is expected to construct the road bumps as part of the subdivision improvements.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution authorizing the placement of two road bumps on Muriel Drive.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF
TWO ROAD BUMPS ON MURIEL DRIVE

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2000, the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors approved a revised Policy and Design Criteria for the placement of road bumps on County maintained roads and within County Service Areas; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Muriel Drive have submitted an application along with a signed petition of affirmation with a **78.6%** calculated approval rate for the installation of two road bumps; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Muriel Drive have complied with all the provisions of the Road Bump Policy; and

WHEREAS, the developer of Tract 1427, Assessor's Parcel Numbers 029-151-05 and 13 pursuant to Permit Number 99-0398, to construct fifteen single family homes, condition D 1. c., shall assume responsibility for the cost of installing two road bumps; and

WHEREAS, Muriel Drive as a local street meets all the eligible requirements for placement of road bumps; and

WHEREAS, the Road Bump Policy requires approval by the Board of Supervisors prior to placement of the bumps.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that two road bumps be installed on Muriel Drive in conformance with the Road Bump Policy and the Road Bump Design Criteria.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the developer of Tract 1427 pay the cost of installing the two road bumps.

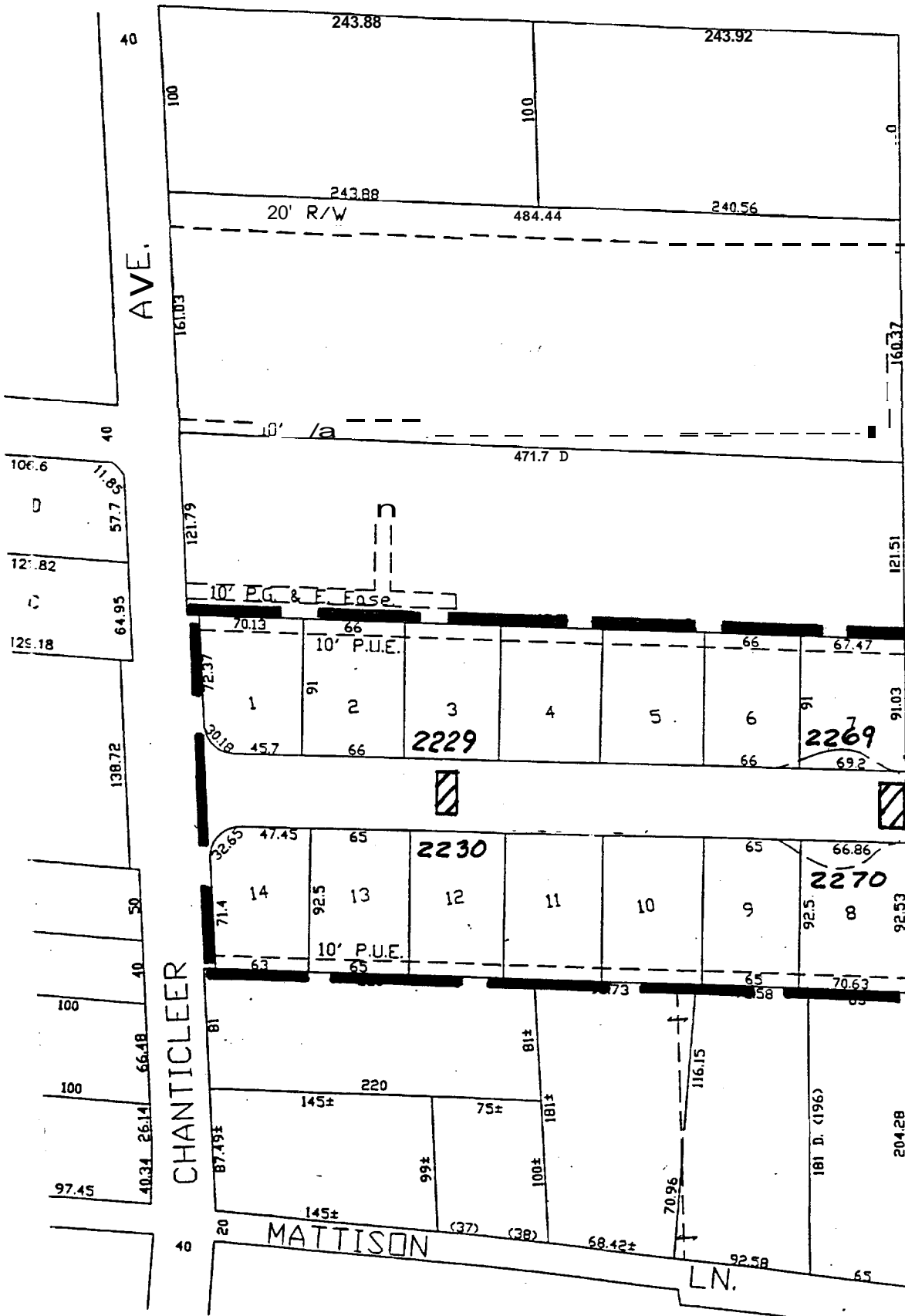
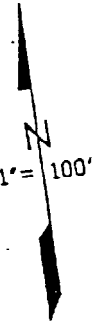
