ORDINANCE NO.

ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION L OF SECTION 3.12.040 OF THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY CODE RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS OF COUNTY EMPLOYEES FROM CIVIL SERVICE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Subsection L of Section 3.12.040 of the Santa Cruz County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- L. The following particular classifications or officers:
 - 1. Assistant County Administrative officer and assistant County administrative officer/planning director,
 - Chief probation officer; provided, however, that the examination for vacancies in this office be conducted in accordance with traditional merit system procedures,
 - 3. Chief deputy district attorney,
 - 4. County administrative officer,
 - 5. Court reporter,
 - 6. Deputy jury commissioner,
 - 7. Jury commissioner,
 - 8. Judicial secretary (superior court),
 - 9. Senior board clerk (public works),
 - 10. Sheriff's chief deputy,
 - 11. County supervisors' administrative assistant County supervisors' analyst
 - 12. Superior court administrative secretary
 - 13. Attorney II courts,
 - 14. Traffic referee.
 - 15. Court commissioner,
 - 16. County counsel,
 - 17. Agricultural commissioner director of weights and measures,
 - 18. Attorney I courts,
 - 19. Special qualifications worker,
 - 20. Supervisors' staff assistant
 - 21. Director of public works,
 - 22. Superior court commissioner/referee,
 - 23. Planing director,
 - 24. Attorney III courts
 - 25. Executive officer/clerk superior court,
 - 26. Director of parks, open spaces, and cultural services,

- 27. Health services administrator,
- 28. Chief deputy district attorney administration.

This ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day after the date of final passage.
