SUBJECT: WEBB ROAD, PM 0.63 AND WHEELOCK ROAD, PM 0.15 STORM  
DAMAGE REPAIR, DSRNO. 95058 AND 95057

#### Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject storm damage repair project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for the repair of both storm damaged roads in the south county area which failed during the storms of 1997. Webb Road will require the replacement of a portion of a destroyed culvert bridge. Wheelock Road requires the replacement of a concrete cribwall that supports the County road adjacent to Litchfield Creek. Due to impending Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funding deadlines, it is necessary to proceed with these repairs at this time.

The project, as presented, is limited to those repairs included in the approved Damage Survey Reports (DSR), so as to return the damage sites to their original predisaster condition. The plans and specifications thus provide for a repair that essentially matches the existing roadway in the vicinity of the repair site, pursuant to the FEMA approved scope of work and available funding. In those instances where the funding approved for a DSR repair falls short of the actual bid price, we will submit a supplemental funding request to FEMA requesting that they cover the full cost of repair.

The engineer's estimate for this work is \$350,000, not including contingencies or administration costs. Sufficient funding for the project is included in the approved 2001/2002 Road Program.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids for the Webb Road, PM 0.63 and Wheelock Road, PM 0.15 Storm Damage Repair project.

2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on September 18, 2001
3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning August 26, 2001, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.



This project involves the construction of roadway storm damage repairs, including earthwork, rock slope protection, reinforced concrete crib wall, drainage facilities, paving, metal beam guardrail and erosion control.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond.

The contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time that this contract is awarded.

The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.
