SUBJECT: CAPITOLA ESPLANADE PUMP SYSTEM PROJECT

Members of the Board:

On August 13, 2001, the Public Works Department received the attached letter (Attachment 1) from the City of Capitola Interim Director of Public Works requesting that your Board approve funding for the Capitola Esplanade Pump System Project in the amount of \$160,000. The City of Capitola would fund all its design costs associated with the project.

On January 25, 2000, your Board received a report (Attachment 11) which included a letter from the City of Capitola with the proposed schedule for construction of the project. In response to this earlier letter, your Board elevated the priority of the Capitola Esplanade Pump System Project and approved funding for design. The City of Capitola's current request for construction funding is consistent with its schedule, but line item funding was not included in this year's Zone 5 budget because a request from the City of Capitola was not received prior to completion of the budget. However, sufficient finds are available in Zone 5 contingencies for this purpose. A four-fifths vote of approval is required to move these funds from contingencies.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Directors take the following action:

1. Approve a transfer of \$160,000 to fund the Capitola Esplanade Pump System Project, plus administrative costs, from contingencies into the Zone 5 fixed asset budget.

2. Authorize Zone 5 and the Auditor-Controller to reimburse the City of Capitola for the costs of the project up to an amount not to exceed \$160,000.

Dear Tom;

On January 25, 2000, the Board of Directors of the Zone 5 Flood Control District directed that the subject property be placed as a top priority on the Zone 5 CIP List (D9002) with an estimated cost of \$160,000. During this years budget hearings, the City of Capitola approved an additional amount of \$30,000 of General Fund monies to begin design work on this project and on August 9, 2001, approved of a consultant contract with the further direction that staff request the Zone 5 Board to include this project in their current budget using expansion construction contingencies of \$469,991 to fund the estimated CIP amount of \$160,000.

It is the City of Capitola's desire to expedite the underground project with the goal of beginning work prior to this winters rain season and that the work be completed before beginning the Esplanade section of the Capitola Village Enhancement Phase II improvements.

The project will consist of a pump station and force main line from a low point on Lawn Way, removing flood waters across the Esplanade to the beach area (map attached). The City is formally requesting that the District place this item on their August 28,2001 agenda allowing the use of contingency funds for this capital improvement project.



As directed by your Board on December 7, 1999, we report back today on the Capitola Esplanade Pump System Project and its place on the Zone 5 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) drainage project list (Exhibit "A"). District staff met with the City of Capitola staff to discuss the project and its importance to the City. After that meeting Capitola sent the attached letter. The letter presents Capitola's argument supporting the Capitola Esplanade Pump System Project's elevation on the Zone 5 CIP list. The City has also promised to provide funds for design and they will be seeking construction finds as well. As stated in their letter, this is the City's highest priority project and District staff believes they have made a good case for moving this project up on the priority list. District Staff recommends that the project move up as shown on the revised list.

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
