Statement of interest for Human Services Commissioner for the 5th District

I have been Assistant Director & Mountain Community Resources (formerly Valley Resource Center) since 1996. During that time I've worked with our staff to deliver health and human services to residents of the San Lorenzo Valley. I've participated in the SLV Collaborative to place family advocates in our schools, and worked in partnership with our director to ensure that our agency holds a position of leadership among community based organizations in the county. I'm on the steering, training and tools committees for the Family Resource Center Network (FRCN), and participate in the home visiting management group for agencies funded through the Children and Families Commission.

I have experience in training and program evaluation. Currently, I contract with Cal State University Monterey Bay's Institute for Community Collaborative Studies to help agency staff integrate the Family Development Matrix (FDM) into their work with families. The FDM is an outcomes based measurement tool used to track family progress. We are training FRCN agencies to use the tool, as well as agencies in Alameda, Santa Clara and San Mateo counties, and in Toledo, Ohio.

I'm interested in participating in local discussions about how we structure, evaluate and fund human services in our county. Please consider me for appointment to the Human Services Commission.
