### SUBJECT: PROPOSITION 12 FUNDS


Dear Members of the Board:

On May 8, 2001, your Board deferred the Parks Commission's report with regard to the utilization of the Proposition 12 Funds. As you will recall, Proposition 12 includes funding which can be utilized for acquisition, development, rehabilitation and restoration of real property for park purposes. It is anticipated that the County will receive approximately 1.4 million dollars of Proposition 12 Funds.


The Commission's meeting agendas have been extremely busy with Public Hearings concerning the Pinto Lake Master Plan Amendment, the Moran Lake Habitat Plan, the proposed Highlands Skate Board feature, and other items and therefore have not had an opportunity to discuss Proposition 12 funding. It is anticipated that the Commission will complete its discussion of Proposition 12 funding at its next few meetings.
