Unified Fee Schedule

Dear Members of the Board:

Attached are the proposed revisions to the Unified Fee Schedule from various County departments. The revisions are accompanied by fee information sheets that provide an explanation of the recommended fee changes.

The Director of the General Services Department recommends:

An increase to fees to cover the cost of reproducing blueprints and bid specification.

The Administrator of the Human Resources Agency recommends:

• An increase of \$4 per unit in the monthly fee charged for Fiscal Conservatorship services and Representative Payee services. These modifications will bring the fees in line with increases in fees approved by the Social Security Administration.

The Director of Parks, Open Space, and Cultural Services recommends:

• The establishment of a \$400 annual fee for sponsoring dog stations in County parks. In addition, modifications are recommended to correct errors that were inadvertently incorporated into the fee schedule in June **2001**.

The Director of the Public Works Department recommends:

- The shift of a number of fees from a specified weighted hourly rate to actual costs. These changes are possible because the new cost accounting management system easily generates reports of all costs associated with individual projects.
- Changes to fees for microfilm copies, maps and other reproducibles, and roll stock prints based on the services now being provided
- New fees for copies of GIS maps and the Drainage Development Review Group services, and

An increase in the Planning Review Fee for new single family dwellings to cover the cost of the service.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the Unified Fee Schedule and adopt the attached resolution revising the Unified Fee Schedule with the amended fees and charges as presented.
