SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF UNANTICIPATED REVENUE WILDER RANCH BIKE PATH PROJECT

Members of the Board:

On September 6,2001, the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission approved an amendment to its fiscal year 2001-2002 budget and work program which authorized an additional \$13,569 in Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds for the County of Santa Cruz.

The Department of Public Works recommends that the additional TDA funds be appropriated for the Wilder Ranch Bike Path project to help finance the completion of the project. The project originally included a prefabricated steel truss bridge, but the California State Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) recently informed the County that this bridge design is no longer acceptable and a different type of bridge will need to be designed. This will delay the project completion until next summer.

The CALTRANS District 5 staff realizes that this major delay is primarily due to internal state procedures and is willing to work with us to provide the necessary support to complete the project. County staff is currently negotiating with CALTRANS to amend the Cooperative Agreement to provide for design of a concrete slab bridge in lieu of the prefabricated steel truss bridge, and for CALTRANS to fund an additional \$100,000 to \$150,000 of the construction costs. We anticipate the new bridge design to be completed by CALTRANS in April 2002, with completion of the bike path project in August 2002.

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It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of **\$13,569** from the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission for the Wilder Ranch Bike Path project.
