#### SUBJECT: INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

#### Members of the Board:

On August 1,2000, your Board approved an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) policy for County owned property and approved a contract with the Regents of the University of California to implement the IPM policy adopted by your Board. The IPM coordinator and the advisory group have met regularly and made significant progress in implementing the IPM policy.

Implementation of the policy in regard to control of burrowing rodents on the Salsipuedes and Pajaro River levees has proven problematic. Control of burrowing rodents is necessary to preserve the integrity of the levees for flood control purposes and is required by the Army Corps of Engineers. Current rodent control methods utilize a Category I pesticide, Fumitoxin, with the active ingredient aluminum phosphide. Pesticide pellets are placed in rodent burrows and the entrance is then blocked with soil. Naturally occurring moisture in the soil activates the pellets and releases a pesticidal gas which controls the rodents.

The IPM advisory group has been unable to identify a cost effective alternative to this Category I pesticide and therefore recommended that we seek advice from experts in the field of burrowing rodent control.


The IPM coordinator contacted a team of vertebrate pest control specialists from the University of California at Davis. This group proposes to study a representative segment of the levee system, evaluate several different methods of rodent control, and report on their applicability and cost effectiveness for a not to exceed amount of \$13,400. The IPM coordinator has indicated that they will be able to fund most of this study within the existing contract, but will require a slight contract increase of \$5,000 to fully fund this extra work.

Attached for your approval is an amendment to agreement to add this work and \$5,000 to the current contract with the University and an AUD-74 transferring \$5,000 from Pajaro Storm Drain Maintenance District contingencies to provide the additional funding.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the attached amendment to agreement increasing the contract with the Regents of the University of California by \$5,000 for evaluation of methods to control burrowing rodents on the Salsipuedes and Pajaro River levees to a not-to-exceed amount of \$50,000.
2. Approve the attached AUD-74 transferring \$5,000 from contingencies to operating transfers out in the Pajaro Storm Drain Maintenance District budget.
3. Adopt resolution accepting and appropriating unanticipated revenue from the Pajaro Storm Drain Maintenance District to the Agricultural Extension budget in the amount of \$5,000.


