SUBJECT: SALSIPUEDES CREEK LEVEE STABILIZATION PROJECT
PUBLIC HEARING FOR ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REPORT

Members of the Board:

On August 3, 1999, your Board executed and authorized by Resolution No. 349-99 a contract with the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for a State Disaster Recovery Initiative (DRI) Grant Agreement. This grant provides \$555,440 in funding for a repair project along the Salsipuedes Creek levee. The proposed project consists of installing approximately 650 linear feet of sheet piles into the existing western Salsipuedes Creek levee downstream of the State Highway 129 crossing to eliminate a series of seeps and reestablish the levee integrity.

The administrative requirements under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program are numerous and complex. One of the requirements is an annual grantee performance report. As part of the annual performance report, a noticed public hearing is required to report to the public progress made on CDBG activities. The public hearing must be held prior to submission of the report to HCD and must allow interested parties to comment on CDBG grant performance to date. Attached are the annual grantee performance reports.


It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:


