APPROVE AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT WITH CABRILLO COLLEGE

Dear Members of the Board:

On March 6,2001 your Board approved a contract with the Cabrillo College Fast Track to Work (FTTW) Program for the Retention, Advancement, Mobility Pilot (RAMP) to provide follow up employment services for CalWORKs participants moving out of training programs and into the workforce. The purpose of this letter is to request your Board's approval of a contract amendment to extend the student service component to June 30,2002. This amendment will increase the contract budget by \$11,138 for a total amount of \$63,138. Funds for this amended agreement are available from the CalWORKs single allocation and are included in the Human Resource Agency Budget for FY 2001-2002.

The student service component of RAMP provides skill instruction, career guidance, and information and referral services for CalWORKs participants completing FTTW instructional programs and entering the workforce. Initially, the service component of this contract was scheduled to end March 30,2002, however, due to a recent increase in student enrollment an extension is needed.

IT **IS** THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board approve the attached contract amendment with the Cabrillo College Fast Track to Work Program to extend student services and increase the contract by \$ 11,138 and authorize the Human Resources Agency Administrator to sign the contract on behalf of the County, **as** recommended by the Human Resources Agency Administrator.

AMENDMENT TO HUMAN RESOURCES AGENCY CONTRACT # 2358

The County of Santa Cruz, by and through the Human Resources Agency, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY" and Cabrillo College Fast Track To Work Program, hereinafter called the "CONTRACTOR' hereby modify contract #2358. The purpose of this Amendment is to revise the Scope of Work, extending for three months the service component of this project from April 1,2002 to June 30,2002 and to increase the total budget amount to \$63,138. The provisions of this Amendment shall be effective from April 1,2002 through June 30,2002. All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.

(A) Item #2, COMPENSATION, paragraph 2 is amended to read:

Reimbursement of program costs not to exceed \$ 63,138 on the basis of suitable invoices, as specified in the BUDGET, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Costs incurred between March 6,2001 and June 30,2001 shall not exceed \$20,000 and costs incurred between July 1,2001 and June 30,2002 shall not exceed \$43,138.

SCOPE OF WORK

CABRILLO COLLEGE – FAST TRACK TO WORK Retention, Advancement, Mobility Pilot (RAMP)

<u>DUTIES:</u> CONTRACTOR agrees to exercise special skill to accomplish the following results:

Provide post employment career advancement information for employed CalWORKs Fast Track to Work participants and former participants.

- Identify and recruit FTTW participants, graduates and former participants to participate in career advancement activities.
- Provide life skill instruction, information on educational and career advancement opportunities, and individual career instructional services to enhance the ability of former FTTW participants to increase their earning potential and advance in their chosen occupation.
- Collect FTTW program outcome information related to employment and family well being. Data elements to be collected and the method of outcome evaluation must be pre-approved by the HRA-Careerworks Contract Analyst assigned to this project.
- CalWORKs student services will be provided from April 1, 2001 through June 30,2002. During this
 phase CONTRACTOR will provide quarterly reports to the HRA Contract Analyst specifying the
 names and Social Security numbers of CalWORKs participants served. CONTRACTOR will publish a
 final report on project findings and outcomes by July 30, 2002 (Revised January 29, 2002).

CLAIM PROCESS:

CONTRACTOR will submit a monthly claim within 20 working day following the end of each month. Claim forms must include the amount of program expenditures associated with each budget line item as listed on Attachment **A**. The final claim for fiscal year 2000-2001 activities must be submitted no later than July 15,2001 and shall not exceed the amount specified for the fiscal year on page one of this contract. The final claim 2001-2002 activities must be submitted no later than July 25, 2002 and shall not exceed the amount specified for the fiscal year on page one of this contract. Claim forms must be approved by the COUNTY and will require CONTRACTOR certification.
