SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT FUNDS FOR A PORTION OF LOCAL FUNDING FOR A SAN LORENZO VALLEY TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY

Members of the Board:

The Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission is requesting applications for the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Demonstration Program. The program provides annual grant funding for special one-time "demonstration" projects, or start-ups for a potential longer term transportation project or program. The applications are due by January 30, 2002, for the 2001/2002 fiscal year. There is \$93,000 in grant funds available on a county-wide basis, and individual agencies may apply up to \$20,000 for each project/program.

Late last year the Department of Public Works submitted an application for a San Lorenzo Valley Trail Feasibility Study through a California Department of Transportation Community Based Transportation Planning Program for fiscal year 2001/02. The total project cost for the trail feasibility study is estimated at \$178,000 with \$38,000 from local funds and in-kind services. The TDA grant application request is for \$20,000, and it is proposed to supplement the local match that would be required for the trail feasibility study.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution approving submission of a grant application for funds from the TDA Demonstration Program.



RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR
THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Demonstration Program is a program administered by the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission to provide funding for special one-time "demonstration" projects/programs; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2001, the County submitted an application for a San Lorenzo Valley Trail Feasibility Study through a CALTRANS Community Based Transportation Planning Grant for fiscal year 2001/02; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the Feasibility Study was \$178,000 with \$38,000 from local funds and in-kind services; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz has prepared an application for grant funding from the TDA Demonstration Program in the fiscal year 2001/02 funding cycle for a portion of the local funds needed for the San Lorenzo Valley Trail Feasibility Study; and

WHEREAS, the application requests TDA funding of \$20,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz:

1. Approves the submission of the grant application for the TDA Demonstration Program.
2. Agrees to act as the claimant for this grant and requests funds, if grant is approved.
3. Authorizes Thomas L. Bolich, Director of Public Works and the Department of Public Works as the official representative of Santa Cruz County to administer, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to: application, agreements, amendments, payment requests, etc. which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.


