IN THE PURSUIT OF BREVITY, THERE IS MUCH I COULD ADD BUT, I THINK, WITH A LITTLE THOUGHT AND IMAGINATION, ONE COULD SEE THE POTENTIAL POSSIBILITY OF MORE INVOLVEMENT WITH THE MANY OF OUR PEOPLE WHO ON NOT ALWAYS REALIZE JUST HOW MUCH HELP IS AVAILABLE WHEN WE REALLY NEED IT.
