

- a) Name of claimant: City of Santa Cruz
- b) Address to which notices are to be sent: Office of the Risk Manager, Room 7, City Hall, 809 Center Street, Santa Cruz, CA 95060.
- c) The date and place of the occurrence giving rise to the claim asserted: On or about May 10, 2001, a contractor of the County of Santa Cruz damaged a City owned water main in the area of 24th Avenue and East Cliff Drive in Santa Cruz, California, while working on a County project. This damage required the City to expend \$15,664.75 to make necessary repairs.
- d) A general description of the damages incurred: See c), above.
- e) The names of the employees or agents of the County of Santa Cruz which caused the damage: It is believed that the contractor which caused the above-described damage while acting on behalf of the County of Santa Cruz is known as ARB. The names of any County employees who may have also caused this damage are unknown.
