Dear Members of the Board:

The term of office of a number of at-large positions on various County advisory bodies will expire **on** April 1, 2002. These vacancies include the following:

Children and Families Commission

1. Two members selected from among the following:
 - a. The county health officer;
 - b. A county employee responsible for the management of children's services;
 - c. A county employee responsible for the management of public health services;
 - d. A county employee responsible for the management of behavioral health services;
 - e. **A** county employee responsible for the management of tobacco and other substance abuse prevention and treatment services;
 - f. **A** county employee responsible for the management of social services.

2. One member selected from among the following:
 - a. Those persons described in Item 1 above;
 - b. Those recipients **of** project services included in the county's strategic plan;
 - c. Educators specializing in early childhood development;
 - d. Representatives of a local child care resource or referral agency;
 - e. A local child care coordinating group;
 - f. Representatives **of** a local organization for prevention or early intervention for families at risk;
 - g. Representatives of community-based organizations that have the goal of promoting nurturing and early childhood development;
 - h. Representatives of local school districts;
 - i. Representatives **of** local medical, pediatric, or obstetric associations or societies.

Environmental Health Appeals Commission

One vacancy:

- a. Member with knowledge of soils and/or groundwater hydrology

Hazardous Materials Appeals Commission

Two vacancies:

- a. One public member
- b. One Industry representative using **or** who has used one or more hazardous materials

Long Term Care Interagency Commission

Seven vacancies:

- a. Two persons over age 55
- b. Younger functionally impaired adult - age 18-55
- c. Representative of a health facility providing acute or long term care to the elderly
- d. Person who has demonstrated an interest in alternatives to institutional long term care
- e. Representative of local independent living centers
- f. Person with demonstrated interest in the area of Organic Brain Syndrome
