SUBJECT: SPANISH RANCH ROAD PM 0.20 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject storm damage repair project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for the repair of 1998 El Niño storm damage along Spanish Ranch Road at Post Mile 0.20 through the installation of a standard embankment cribwall for purposes of restoring pavement width to the road.

The project, as presented, is limited to those repairs included in the approved Damage Survey Reports (DSR), to return the damage site to its original predisaster condition. The plans and specifications provide for a repair that essentially matches the existing roadway in the vicinity of the repair site, pursuant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) approved scope of work and available funding. In those instances where the funding approved for a DSR repair falls short of the actual bid price, we will submit a supplemental funding request to FEMA requesting that they cover the full cost of repair.

The engineer's estimate for this work is \$104,300 not including contingencies or administration costs. Sufficient funding for the project was included in the approved 2001/2002 Road Program.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineers estimate and authorize calling for bids for the Spanish Ranch Road P.M. 0.20 Storm Damage Repair.

2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on February 26,2002.
3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning February 3,2002, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.
