Resolution Re-authorizing the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council Through June 30, 2003

Dear Board Members:

On April 17,2001, your Board approved the Probation Department's submission of the County's Multi-Agency Juvenile Justice Plan and Funding Application to the State Board of Corrections (BOC) for the Schiff-Cardenas Crime Prevention Act of 2000 program. The fbnding application was approved by the BOC on April 23,2001, and funds in the amount of \$935,737 were included in the supplemental budget for FY 2001-02. The BOC recently provided information regarding the second allocation of funds for programs included in the County's approved spending plan. Recent changes as a result of SB 736 require the local Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council to review and modify annually its comprehensive plan, and for the County Board of Supervisors and State Board of Corrections to approve the modified plan. Changes also include the removal of the sunset clause for the program, which is now titled the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) program. Second year funding for Santa Cruz County is \$867,945.

As a result of these changes, the County will need to reconvene the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council to review and agree that the programs in the existing plan are viable, review potential budget changes, and secure a required Board of Supervisors resolution approving the program modifications on or before April 23, 2002.

The attached resolution identifies the proposed members of the JJCC, updated due to various personnel changes. The Probation Department will be convening the JJCC in April 2002 to review and update the County's Multi-Agency Juvenile Justice Plan and Funding Application, and will return to your Board for final approval to submit the modification to the Board of Corrections no later than May 1,2002.

IT **IS** THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Adopt the attached resolution approving the membership and re-authorizing the Santa Cruz County Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council through June 30,2003; and
- 2. Direct the Probation Department to return to your Board on or before April 23,2002 with a report on the revisions to the Multi-Agency Juvenile Justice Plan and Funding Application for the Board of Corrections Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act Program.
