SUBJECT: LIVE OAK PARKING PROGRAM

Members of the Board:

The Live Oak Parking Program completed its twenty-first season of operation on September 4, 2001. It is recommended that the 2002 Live Oak Parking Program commence March 23, 2002, and continue through September 2, 2002, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. This will once again allow the program to be in full operation during the Easter/spring weekend.

In order to improve parking conditions within the permit zone area and address resident concerns, and in accordance with County Code, Section 9.44.190, this year's Live Oak Parking Program will be expanded to incorporate parking attendant enforcement of the following parking violations within the Live Oak Parking Program permit zone during the permit season on Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday only:

1. parking diagonally where posted "parallel only" County Code Section 9.36.010F
2. parking in a no parking zone County Code Section 9.36.010F
3. parking in a bicycle lane County Code Section 9.36.060
4. parking unlawfully, blocking a driveway (California Vehicle Code 22500e)

The fines for the above violations are set by Resolution No. 606-93, which establishes parking violation penalties.

The expanded activities will be coordinated with the Sheriff's Department and the California Highway Patrol and in conjunction with said agencies will be monitored and assessed on an ongoing basis throughout the parking permit season. For violations related to CVC 22500e (parking unlawfully blocking a driveway), Live Oak parking attendants will be instructed to issue citations for only nonresident vehicles blocking driveways. It is not Public Works' intention to ticket residents parked in front of their own driveway.

Zone boundaries for the Live Oak Parking Program are shown on the attached map (Attachment No. 1) and are designated in the Resolution Establishing the Live Oak Permit Parking Zone for 2002. A petition to include 35th Avenue and St. Deyns Street has been received by the Public Works Department and is being processed by the Planning Department. The petition is scheduled for the Zoning Administrator's review on March 1,2002. A revised resolution will be presented to your Board, including this area, should the permit be approved during or prior to the permit season.


In prior years the Live Oak Parking Program Annual Status Report submitted to your Board has been based on revenue and expenditures incurred within the fiscal year. With the capabilities of the CAMS cost management system we can better reflect the seasonal activities of the 2001 Live Oak Parking Program to include the appropriate time period, which spans two fiscal years. This information is included in Attachment No. 2.

County Code Chapter 9.44 prescribes that the Live Oak parking zone, fees, and period of restricted parking for the program must be established by resolution. These resolutions are attached for your Board's review and adoption.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Accept and file the attached 2001 Live Oak Parking Program Report.
2. Direct the Public Works Department to initiate the 2002 Live Oak Parking Program.
3. Adopt the attached resolutions establishing the parking fees, parking zones, and period of restricted parking for the 2002 Live Oak Parking Program.



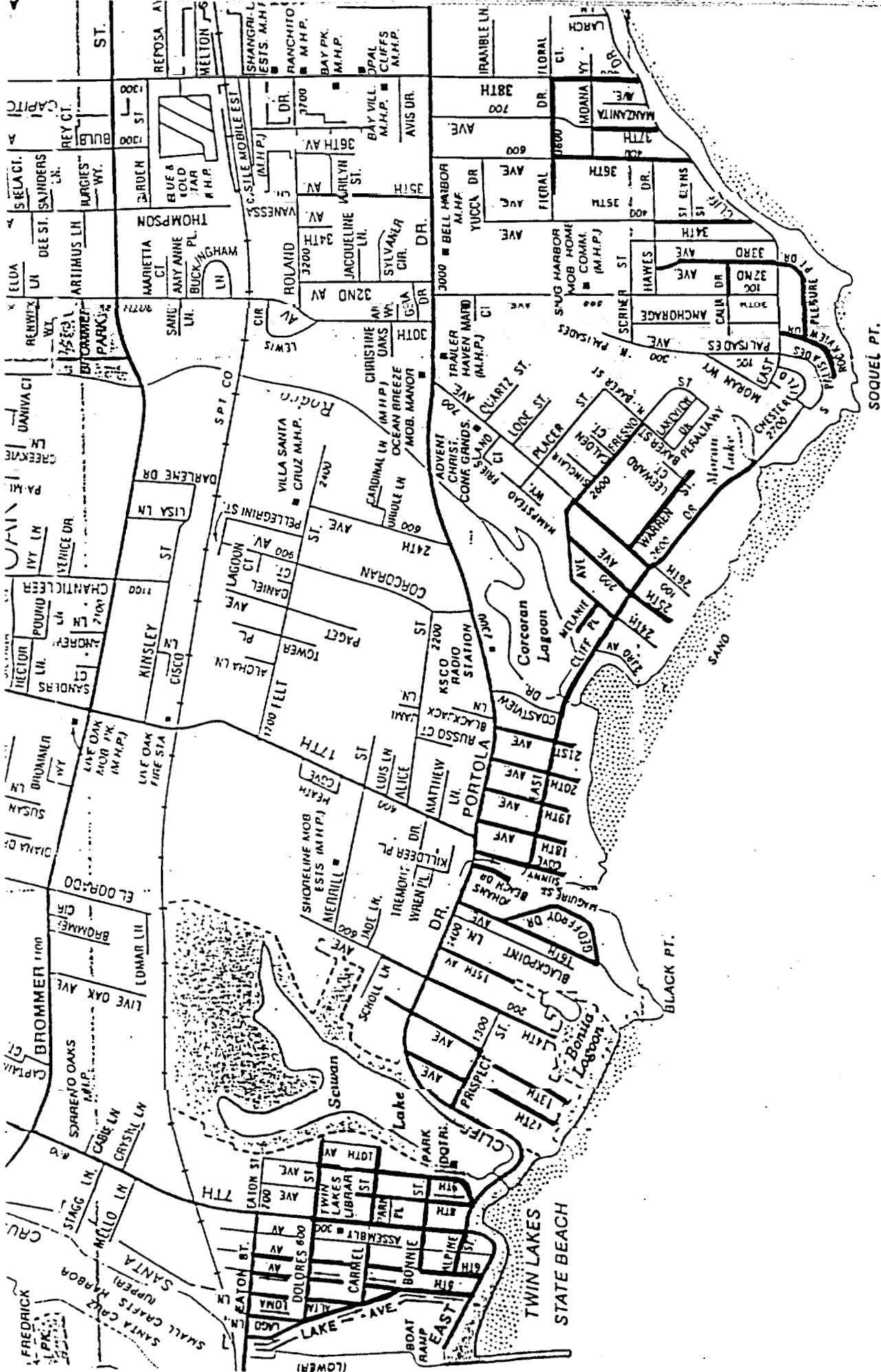

Summary Report

The 2001 Live Oak Parking Program again met the goals of reducing traffic congestion in beach neighborhoods. This was the twenty-first year of permit operations.

Term: The 2001 Live Oak Parking Program began April 15, 2001, and ended September 4, 2001

Staff: The 2001 staff consisted of a full-time program manager, five seasonal parking attendants, and one clerical position.

WHEREAS, Section 9.44.030 of said Chapter authorizes said Board to establish by resolution the Live Oak Parking Zone in which parking will be permitted by display of a valid permit; and

WHEREAS, said Live Oak Parking Zone was modified and adopted for the 2001 beach season on February 28, 2001, by Resolution 63-2001.

WHEREAS, said Zone is to be established for the 2002 Parking Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz establishes that:

(1) Resolution 63-2001 is hereby rescinded.

(2) Permit parking regulations in the Live Oak Parking Zone unless otherwise noted will apply to both sides of each street herein below enumerated:



RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING 2002 FEES FOR
PERMIT PARKING IN THE LIVE OAK BEACH AREA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz has adopted Chapter **9.44** of the Santa Cruz County Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.44.050 of said Chapter authorizes said Board to establish by resolution fees for parking permits in the Live Oak Parking Zone; and

WHEREAS, said Board adopted fees for the 2001 Live Oak Parking Program on February 28, 2001, by Resolution No. 62-001; and

WHEREAS, said fees are to be established for the 2002 Parking Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz establishes that:

- (1) Resolution No. 62-2001 is hereby rescinded.
- (2) The fee for each parking permit for vehicles owned by, or under the control of, occupants or owners of a residence in the permit parking zone shall be no charge for two permits, and five dollars (\$5.00) for each additional permit.
- (3) The fee for parking permit for a guest of a resident of the Parking Zone shall be five dollars (\$5.00).
- (4) The parking permit fee for non-resident vehicles not included in paragraphs 2 and 3 above shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per day or twenty-two (\$22.00) per year.


