Dear Members of the Board:

Attached is a resolution calling for the appointment of unopposed candidates who filed Declarations of Candidacy with the Elections Department for the following Central Committees or County Council:

- Democratic Central Committee, 1st District
- Democratic Central Committee, 5th District
- Republican Central Committee, 4th District
- Libertarian Party Central Committee
- Reform Party County Council

Due to an insufficient number of candidates, the Central Committees and County Council did not appear on the March 5, 2002 ballot. The 4th District Democratic Central Committee, American Independent Party Central Committee in all five supervisorial districts and the Natural Law Party Central Committee also did not appear on the ballot because there were no nominees.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 7228, 7423, 7673, and 7772.1, the Board of Supervisors shall declare elected the candidates who have been nominated, and those candidates shall be entitled to receive certificates of election in the same manner as other candidates elected to a central committee.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

- ADOPT the resolution declaring elected the unopposed Central Committee and County Council candidates who have filed Declarations of Candidacy for the March 5, 2002 Primary Election.


