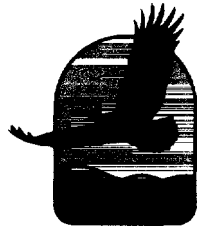


Dear Board Members:



1. That Angelica Diaz is hereby nominated by Council to the County of Santa Cruz **LATINO AFFAIRS COMMISSION.**


2. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the persons nominated and to the Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County.


