To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to California Government Code, Claimant, Connie Banegas, presents the following claim against the County of Santa Cruz.

Claimant Connie Banegas' address is 663 E. Malone St., Hanford, California.

County of Santa Cruz should send all notices regarding this claim to Sawl & Netzer, attention John R. Malmo, Attorney at Law, 2150 Tulare Street, Fresno, CA 93721.

Claimant seeks damages arising from an incident, which occurred on October 4, 2001, in the County of Santa Cruz. Claimant Banegas' left leg was broken, and her knee injured, while she was in the Santa Cruz County Jail. Claimant Banegas' left leg was broken as the result of excessive, unlawful, unreasonable, unconstitutional and malicious use of force on her body. She was thus denied her Civil Rights.

Claimant's injury was a fracture, and other injuries, to her left knee and leg.

The total amount of damages is uncalculated at this time; however, the amount in the controversy is in excess of the minimal jurisdiction requirement of the Superior Court, and jurisdiction and over the claims would properly rest in the Superior Court of California or in the United States Federal District Court.
