REOUEST TO ADVERTISE: BROMMER PARK PLAY AREA AND PATH RENOVATION

Members of the Board:

As part of the FY 01/02 County Budget, your Board allocated Redevelopment Agency, Live Oak Park Dedication and CSA 11 funds to provide labor and materials for the Brommer Park Play Area and Path Renovation Project, #01C1-013. This project will consist of the removal and disposal of existing play structures and pathway, and their replacement with ADA/CPSC compliant play structures and pathway. Because of safety and access concerns, the Redevelopment Agency, General Services and Parks Departments are recommending that the County proceed with this capital project. Architectural services have been provided by Lechner Associates for this project. Plans and specifications have been completed and these items and associated documents, related to this project, must be approved by your Board prior to solicitation of written proposals. Funds for this project are available in the following Budget Indexes: 611135/9842; 194956/6610; 192040/6610; and 134910/6610. The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$188,900.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions:

- 1. Approve plans and specifications on file with the Clerk of the Board for the Brommer Park Play Area and Path Renovation;
- 2. Direct the General Services Department to advertise for bids; and
- 3. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on May 7,2002.
