TYPES OF CASES ADJUDICATED BY HEARING BOARDS

The Health and Safety Code delegates to the hearing boards the authority to hear and decide three types of cases: applications for variances, requests for abatement orders, and permit Qsputes. Although the conduct of these hearings varies somewhat from district to district because hearing boards may adopt their own procedural rules, some uniformity is insured because the basic requirements are set forth in the Health and Safety Code and, pursuant to section 40807, the hearing board rules must conform as far as practicable to the rules for administrative adjudication by state agencies found in the California Administrative Procedures Act, Government Code Sections 11500-11528.
