


- 1 Public Member (position currently being served by Alan Holbert – term to expire April 30th 2002)
- 1 Public Member (position currently being served by Michael Leach – term to expire April 30th 2002)
- 1 Attorney (position currently being served by James King – term to expire August 2002)
- 1 Registered Engineer (position currently being served by Dan Weatherly) – term to expire August 2002)

State law mandates that the Hearing Board be comprised of five members representing 2 Public Members, 1 Attorney, 1 Registered Engineer and 1 Physician. Each of the three counties may submit nominees for these positions. A Committee of the District's Board of Directors will review all nominations submitted and recommend a nominee to the full District Board. The Directors will make the final appointment.

Enclosed is an informational sheet regarding the types of cases considered by the Hearing Board, along with a copy of the application form to be completed by nominees.

TYPES OF CASES ADJUDICATED BY HEARING BOARDS

The Health and Safety Code delegates to the hearing boards the authority to hear and decide three types of cases: applications for variances, requests for abatement orders, and permit Qspites. Although the conduct of these hearings varies somewhat from district to district because hearing boards may adopt their own procedural rules, some uniformity is insured because the basic requirements are set forth in the Health and Safety Code and, pursuant to section 40807, the hearing board rules must conform as far as practicable to the rules for administrative adjudication by state agencies found in the California Administrative Procedures Act, Government Code Sections 11500-11528.
