SUBJECT: TWO BAR ROAD, P.M. 2.35 AND P.M. 2.40 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR
FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY EVENT NO. 1203
DSRNOS. 51458 AND 51461

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject storm damage repair project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for the repair of two road slip outs at the subject sites with the construction of pile and lagging retaining walls, pavement repair, road drainage facilities and guard rail.

The project, as presented, is limited to those repairs included in the approved Damage Survey Reports (DSR), so as to return the damage sites to their original pre-disaster condition. The plans and specifications thus provide for a repair that essentially matches the existing roadway in the vicinity of the repair site, pursuant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) approved scope of work and available funding. In those instances where the funding approved for a DSR repair falls short of the actual bid price, we will submit a supplemental funding request to FEMA requesting that they cover the full cost of repair.


The engineer's estimate for this work is \$205,000, not including contingencies or administration costs. Sufficient funding for the project is included in the approved 2001/2002 Road Program.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids for the Two Bar Road, P.M. 2.35 and P.M. 2.40 Storm Damage Repair project.
2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on June 18, 2002.

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten day period beginning May 26,2002, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.



Sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Director of Public Works of Santa Cruz County, Room 410, Governmental Center, no later than **10:30 a.m., June 18, 2002**, and at 10:45 a.m. or soon after, they will be publicly opened and read in the Supervisors' Hearing Room, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California, for construction on County road in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

**TWO BAR ROAD, PM 2.35 AND P.M. 2.40, STORM DAMAGE REPAIR,
FEMA DSR # 51458 AND 51461**

This project involves the repair of a storm damage portion of Two Bar Road by construction of soldier pile/timber lagging retaining walls, underdrain system, surface drainage system, asphalt pavement repair, metal beam guard rail, asphalt concrete dike, rock energy dissipator, and erosion control and revegetation measures.


Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required. The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond. The Contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time that this contract is awarded.

The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the County has been determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, and such prevailing rate of wages is listed in the State of California, Business and Transportation Agency, Department of Transportation's publication entitled General Prevailing Wage Rates, current edition, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.
