SUBJECT: LIVE OAK PARKING

Members of the Board:

On March 19, 2002, the Board of Supervisors adopted an amended resolution expanding the existing Live Oak Parking zone to include 35th Avenue and St. Deyns Street. In order to allow staff sufficient time to review the proposed expansion, we are recommending that your Board approve the withdrawal of Zoning application no. 01-0202 until further analysis has been completed. In addition, we are requesting that your Board adopt an amended resolution removing these streets from the Live Oak Parking zone.

It is therefore recommended that your Board take the following action:

- 1. Direct Public Works to withdraw Zoning application No. 01-0202 expanding the Live Oak Parking zone to include 35th Avenue and St. Deyns Street.
- 2. Adopt resolution amending resolution establishing the Live *Oak* Parking zone for 2002.

On the motion of Supervisor duly seconded by Supervisor the following resolution is adopted:

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE LIVE OAK PERMIT PARKING ZONE FOR 2002

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz has adopted Chapter 9.44 of the Santa Cruz County Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.44.030 of said Chapter authorizes said Board to establish by resolution the Live Oak Parking zone in which parking will be permitted by display of a valid permit; and

WHEREAS, said Live Oak Parking zone was adopted for the 2002 beach season on March 5,2002, by Resolution 61-2002.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors amended said Live Oak Parking zone for the 2002 beach season, adding 35th Avenue from East Cliff Drive to Hawes Drive and St. Deyns Street to the Live Oak Parking Program on March 19, 2002, by Resolution No. 86-2002; and

WHEREAS, the proposed expansion requires additional time to review prior to inclusion in the Live Oak Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, said zone is to be established for the 2002 Parking Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz establishes that:

- (1) Resolution 86-2002 is hereby rescinded.
- (2) Permit parking regulations in the Live Oak Parking Zone unless otherwise noted will apply to both sides of each street herein below enumerated:

1.	Dolores Street	from Lake Avenue to Tenth Avenue
2.	Carmel Street	from Lake Avenue to Tenth Avenue
3.	Bonnie Street	from Sixth Avenue to Ninth Avenue
4.	Alpine Street	from Sixth Avenue to Seventh Avenue
5.	Lake Avenue	from Carmel Street to Fifth Avenue and the east side only from Lago Lane to Carmel Street.
6.	Alta Loma Lane	from Cannel Street to Eaton Street
7.	Lago Lane	from Eaton Street to its intersection with Lake

8.	Fifth Avenue	from East Cliff Drive to Eaton Street 0453
9.	Sixth Avenue	from East Cliff Drive to Eaton Street
