Members of the Board:

Construction of the Wilder Ranch Bike Path project is expected to begin again in July 2002, and is anticipated to be completed by November 1, 2002. The County hired consultants to monitor the construction activity with regard to archaeology, biotics, and soil conditions. During excavation of a trench for a drainage culvert, the archaeology consultant discovered a layer of midden soil that may contain potential historical artifacts. Construction activity in the area of the drainage culvert was immediately stopped in order to compile a mitigation plan which will be used to identify and recover any historical artifacts in the area.

The Department of Transportation (CALTRANS), in consultation with the State Historic Preservation Office and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, notified the County on October 4, 2001, that the mitigation plan had been approved. On May 7, 2002, your Board approved an amendment to the cooperative agreement in which CALTRANS will be providing an additional \$142,000 to help finance the requirements of the mitigation plan and other components of the project construction. Your Board also adopted a resolution accepting and appropriating this unanticipated revenue for the Wilder Ranch Bike Path project.

The archeology consultant, Garcia and Associates, has worked extensively with CALTRANS to prepare the mitigation plan. In order to complete the work specified in the mitigation plan, it will be necessary to amend the current agreement with Garcia and Associates by increasing the amount of the contract by \$50,000 to an amount not-to-exceed \$72,000, as indicated on the attached amendment to agreement. Funding for this proposed increase is available in the 2001/02 Road Budget using CALTRANS funds as mentioned above.


