SUBJECT: REFUSE, RECYCLING AND YARDWASTE SERVICES CONTRACT

**AMENDMENT** 

Members of the Board:

On February 25, 1997, your Board approved a Franchise Agreement with Waste Management of Santa Cruz County to implement the County's refuse, recycling and yardwaste collection and processing system. This agreement included collection and processing of curbside yardwaste, and continuation of the self-haul woodwaste drop-off and processing program at the County's Buena Vista Landfill and Ben Lomond Transfer Station. The agreement provides for the County to pay Waste Management for all woodwaste processed through the public self-haul woodwaste program. The cost of processing yardwaste collected curbside is included in collection customer service rates.

Payments for woodwaste processing are funded through landfill tipping fees charged to customers who self-haul woodwaste directly to the County solid waste facilities. Due to the unanticipated 11 percent increase in self-haul woodwaste volume and the annual cost-of-living adjustment provided for in the Franchise Agreement, contract funds encumbered for this program at the beginning **of** the 200 1/02 fiscal year are insufficient to cover processing payments through June 30,2002. It will be necessary to increase the allocation for the self-haul woodwaste processing section of the Franchise Agreement by \$60,000 to cover the additional processing costs through the end of the fiscal year.

The Franchise Agreement also includes a County-funded rate stabilization program designed to utilize revenues from sales of curbside recycling materials and other revenues derived from the franchise to offset or defer annual rate increases to franchise customers. The majority of

this fund has come from the sale of recyclables collected through the curbside program. The Franchise Agreement requires Waste Management to share these recycling revenues with the County. The contract allocation for 2001/02 is inadequate to cover costs through the end of this fiscal year. It will be necessary to increase the allocation by \$50,000 to cover rate stabilization payments through the end of the fiscal year.

Use of the rate stabilization fund as discussed above allows the financial benefit gained from sale of curbside recyclables to be returned to the customers by deferral or offsetting of rate increases. A flow chart depicting the flow of funds is attached for your reference. However, due to the cumulative effect of Waste Management's cost of living increases over the last three years and their projected 2 percent to 4 percent service fee increase for next fiscal year, the projected revenues from future recycling sales will no longer be adequate to cover rate stabilization payments in the near future. The County is responsible for setting customer rates for collection services, which have not been increased since the Franchise Agreement was executed in 1997. In order to meet the projected shortfall in next year's rate stabilization fund, a customer service rate increase will be necessary next fiscal year.

As required under Section 7.4 (C) of the Franchise Agreement, Public Works will meet and confer with Waste Management in June 2002 to discuss rate adjustments for the upcoming fiscal year. We will return to your Board on September 24,2002, with proposed rate adjustments.

The total increase in funding for this agreement is \$110,000, for an amended contract not-to-exceed amount of \$930,000. This will cover both the additional \$60,000 for the self-haul woodwaste program and the additional \$50,000 for rate stabilization payments. Sufficient funds are available within the County Service Area No. 9-C Solid Waste 2001/02 Budget for this purpose.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the attached amendment to agreement with Waste Management of Santa Cruz County increasing the contract not-to-exceed amount to \$930,000 and authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the amendment on behalf of the County.

2. Direct Public Works to return on or before September 24,2002, with proposed rate adjustments for franchised refuse, recycling and yardwaste collection services.

### **AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT**

The parties hereto agree to amend Refuse, Recycling and Yardwaste Services Franchise Agreement number 81576, dated February 25,1997, and as amended June 17,1997, April 14, 1998, June 22, 1999, December 12,2000, and June 12,2001, by and between the COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ and WASTE MANAGEMENT OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY. The purpose for this amendment is to: increase the not-to-exceed amount to \$930,000 for additional processing of self-haul woodwaste at the County's Buena Vista Landfill and Ben Lomond Transfer Station and increase in rate stabilization payments.

All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.

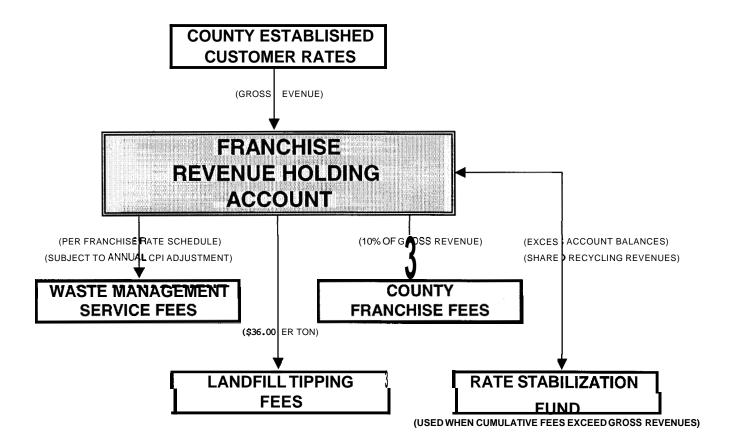
