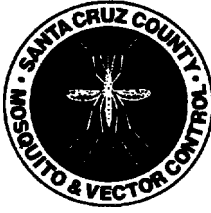

2002-03 Mosquito Abatement Nector Control County Service Area No. 53 Assessment

Dear Members of the Board:

The attached resolutions establish assessment rates for Mosquito Abatement Nector Control County Service Area No. 53 for fiscal year 2002-03 and subsequent fiscal years. These assessments ~~will~~ provide funding necessary to operate a mosquito abatement program in **Zones** of Benefit No. 2 and No. 4 (located within the Aptos and Pajaro districts). There are no changes in the rates established by the Board by Resolution 262-2000 on June 12, 2001 for ~~the~~ 2001-02 fiscal year. There have been no changes in the rates since the 1996-97 fiscal year. **This** year there is a clarification in that mobile homes with land are identified **as** being charged the same rate **as** a single family residence.

Assessment Rate Reports **are** on file with the Clerk **of** the Board for public review. As provided in Chapter 4.26 **of** the County Code, the Assessment Rate Reports must be approved by your Board **and** forwarded to the Auditor-Controller by August 10, 2002.



**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ASSESSMENT RATES FOR
MOSQUITO ABATEMENT/VECTOR CONTROL COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 53**

WHEREAS, Chapter **4.26** of the Santa Cruz County Code requires that a written report regarding the assessments proposed for extended services within county service areas be filed and considered by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the assessment report for the **2002/03** fiscal year within County Service Area No. **53** for Mosquito Abatement / Vector Control has been confirmed by the Board of Supervisors after a duly noticed public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved and Ordered by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz that the following assessments are hereby approved for purposes of Chapter **4.26** of the Santa Cruz County Code:

Section 1. Assessment Rates for parcels within Mosquito Abatement/ Vector Control County Service Area No. **53** for the **2002-03** fiscal year, and for each fiscal year thereafter unless changed by Resolution of the Board adopted after any public hearing and proceeding required by law, shall be per parcel as follows:

Residential Use Category	
Single Family Residence/ Mobile Homes w/Land	\$11.59
Multiple Residential (2-4 units)	\$15.42
Multiple Residential (5 or more units)	\$46.38
Mobile Home Parks	\$46.38
Recreational Use Category	\$16.70
Commercial/Institutional Use Category	\$14.15
Agricultural Use Category	\$11.59
Vacant Category	\$ 5.80

Section 2. Assessment Exemptions: Assessments will not be levied on parcels in the following categories:

1. Common Area Parcels.
2. Parcels with **an** assessed valuation of **\$5,000.00** or less.

3. Unbuildable parcels **as** determined by planning or environmental health regulations. It is the obligation of the parcel owner to provide documentation to verify that a parcel is unbuildable.
4. Parcels used solely for, and dedicated to, providing private water supply to residential areas (well or tank sites).
5. All parcels designated **as** Public parcels.
6. Miscellaneous utility improvements and State Board of Equalization Assessments.
