SUBJECT: SALSIPUEDES CREEK LEVEE STABILIZATION PROJECT
PUBLIC HEARING FOR FINAL GRANTEE PERFORMANCE REPORT

Members of the Board:

On August 3, 1999, your Board executed and authorized by Resolution No. 349-99, a contract with the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for a State Disaster Recovery Initiative (DRI) Grant Agreement. This grant provided \$555,440 in funding for a repair project along the Salsipuedes Creek levee. The project consisted of installing approximately 1,000 linear feet of sheet piles into the existing western Salsipuedes Creek levee downstream of the State Highway 129 crossing to eliminate a series of weeps and reestablish the levee integrity.

This project has since been designed and built. A final grantee performance report is required in order to finalize the contract with HCD. As part of the final performance report a noticed public hearing is required to report to the public progress made on Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) activities. The public hearing must be held prior to submission of the report to HCD and must allow interested parties to comment on CDBG grant performance.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Set a public hearing for review of the Final Grantee Performance Report for contract 99-DRI-005 on August 20, 2002.



If any person challenges an action taken on the foregoing matter(s) in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at or prior to the public hearing.
