SUBJECT: REDWOOD ROAD PM 0.40 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT
OES DSR NO. 054

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject storm damage repair project are now complete and are presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for the repair of storm damage at Redwood Road Post Mile (PM) 0.40 by replacing the existing culvert and headwalls with larger facilities, pavement repair, installation of guardrail, and erosion control mitigation.

The project, as presented, is limited to those repairs included in the approved scope of work of the original Disaster Survey Report, so as to return the site to its original predisaster condition. The plans and specifications thus provide for a repair that essentially matches the existing roadway in the vicinity of the repair site, pursuant to the Office of Emergency Service's (OES) approved scope of work and available funding. Our department requests permission to expedite the award and construction phases of this project in order to get this project constructed this year within the allowable environmental permitting construction window.


The engineer's estimate for this work is \$157,700, not including contingencies or administration costs. Sufficient funding for the project is available in the approved 2002/2003 road budget, utilizing both approved OES funding and County culvert replacement program funding.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids.

2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a fifteen-day period beginning August 10, 2002, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.
3. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on August 27, 2002.
4. Authorize Public Works to return to the Board during the afternoon session on the same day, August 27, 2002, to award this project.




Sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Director of Public Works of Santa Cruz County, Room 410, Governmental Center, no later than **10:30 a.m., August 27, 2002**, and at 10:45 a.m. or soon after, they will be publicly opened and read, in the Supervisors' Hearing Room, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California, for construction on County road in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows: **REDWOOD ROAD PM 0.40, STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT, OES DSR No. 054**

This project involves the repair of a storm-damaged portion of Redwood Road at Post Mile (PM) 0.40 by the installation of a 2438 mm culvert, grouted RSP headwalls, metal beam guard railing, pavement repair, erosion control, and revegetation measures.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond. The Contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time that this contract is awarded.


