

SUBJECT: INSTALLATION OF ONE RESIDENTIAL NON-STANDARD STREET LIGHT

WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 9, ZONE A, 18TH AVENUE

Members of the Board:

The Department of Public Works has received a petition (see Attachment "A") from residents of 18th Avenue in the Live Oak area requesting the installation of one non-standard street light at the location shown on Attachment "B." This area is within the County's residential lighting district, Zone A, of County Service Area (CSA) No. 9.

The petition is signed by all residents or property owners in the immediate vicinity of the proposed light. Further, residents of the neighborhood funded the utility under-grounding including the cost of a post-top luminaire (see Attachment "C") as a neighborhood beautification project. Post-top luminaires are particularly applicable for lighting installations in residential areas with underground distribution, as they provide an aesthetically pleasing daytime appearance as well as enhance the night-time appearance of the surrounding area. The Redevelopment Agency has no objections to the installation of a non-standard street light.

The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has advised us that the installation of a 70-watt, non-standard residential street light is feasible at this location. The installation will result in the standard charge of approximately \$7.75 per month on the County's street lighting bill. Sufficient funding for this new light is available in the CSA No. 9A residential lighting budget. The Supervisor of this area is aware of the request for this light.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors authorize the installation of one 70-watt, non-standard residential street light on 18th Avenue.




